Individual Research Plan – User Notes



How to use the Individual Research Plan

- One person per plan and either one or two goals per sheet

Senario

You want to find out when someone died and where they were buried

Put both these goals on the same sheet as they are related

Senario

You want to find where someone was born and how many children they had

Put each goal on a different sheet

Explanation of the headings on the Individual Research Plan

Name

The name of the person you are preparing this research plan for – put the LAST NAME in capitals. If there is not a surname recorded, do not put one in. Also add in the other details in the top section if you know them. This may help you trace who you are looking for.

Research Goal

What do you want to find, ie: Where is this person buried?

Date

Record here the date that you looked. This column and the results are the last two to be filled in

Where To Look

For example: church register, local urupa, in the storage boxes in the shed. One place to look per line.

Location

Where is the entry in “Where to Look”. For example, Library name, place of urupa etc

Results

Record what you found. If you find what the goal is, write the result. If you do not find what you are looking for make a note of that also, then add in more “Where to Look” lines.
